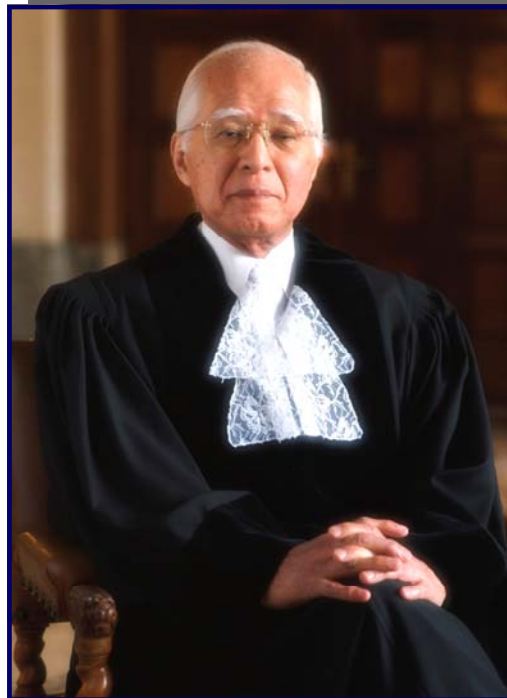

His Excellency Hisashi Owada

Owada was appointed president of the International Court of Justice (ICJ) in The Hague in 2009, following his service as a judge for the ICJ since 2003. The ICJ is the principal judicial organ of the United Nations. Before being appointed to this post, President Owada served as president of the Japan Institute of International

Affairs, Deputy Foreign Minister of Japan, as well as Japan's Permanent Representative to the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) in Paris and as Permanent Representative to the U.N. in New York.

President Owada taught at the University of Tokyo for 25 years and at Harvard, Columbia, and New York University Law Schools. He is currently on the faculty of the NYU Global Law School and honorary professor at Leiden University in the Netherlands. He has authored numerous publications on international legal affairs.
